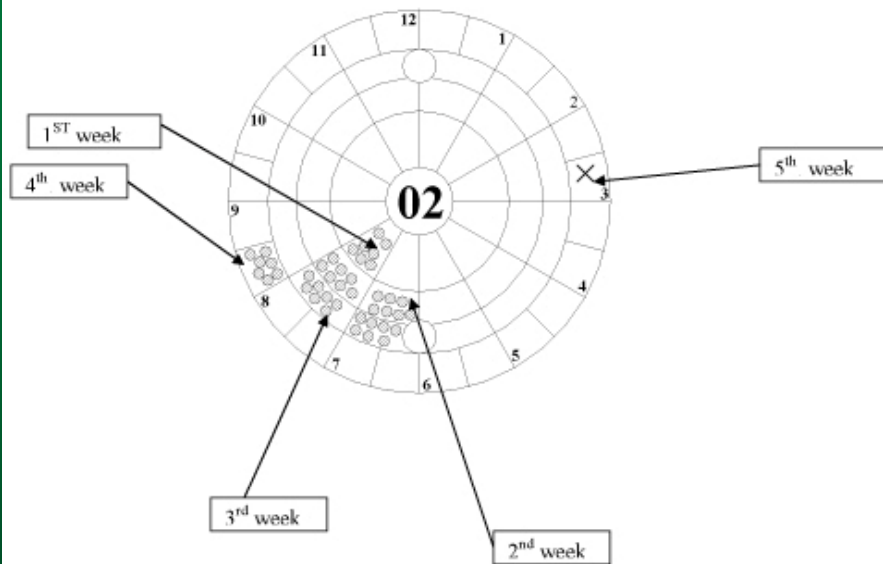


Quality and Traceability Standards

Instructions on how to read the date wheel.



Always read this from the inside ring out.

1st week. The 8th month (Aug.) of year 2002 we ran the product all seven days the 1st week (as shown above).

2nd week. We ran production on 7th month (Jul.) and 8th month (Aug.) for seven days on the second week of the months.

3rd week. We ran production on 7th month (Jul.) and 8th month (Aug.) for seven days on the third week of the months.

4th week. We ran production on 9th month (Sep.) for seven days on the fourth week of Sep.

5th week. We ran production on 3rd month (Mar.) only one day on the last week of March.

- All chambers & End Caps have date wheel
- Trace date and shift when produced
- Lot numbers given to all material orders and are tied to production schedule/shifts
- Records are kept for 50 years
- Lowest PPM rates in the industry including all class A surface parts
